





Teaching and Learning at St Philips C of E Primary School

<div data-bbox="193 412 464 589">  <p>THE VERY HUNGRY CATERPILLAR by Eric Carle</p> </div> <div data-bbox="533 405 799 622">  <p>The Bad-Tempered Ladybird Eric Carle</p> </div> <p>Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This half term we will be learning to write sentences, including re-reading what they have written to check that it makes sense. We will cover a range of poetry, fiction and non fiction books. Some of the books we will be looking at are 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle and 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird' also by Eric Carle. 	<div data-bbox="976 412 1203 761">  </div> <p>Numeracy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reception will learn to count and recognise numbers beyond 10. Numerical Patterns Reception will explore 3D shapes and their properties.
<p>Communication and language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will have lots of discussions about our own experiences of the world around us and will be providing lots of opportunities for children to ask questions to find out more. We will be listening carefully to rhymes and songs paying attention to how they sound. 	<p>RE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This half term we are learning about where we belong and how we are loved and cared for. We will also be having discussions on the Muslim, Christian, Jewish and other communities we belong to.
<p>PSED</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Self-regulation: Reception will be learning to show resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge. Managing Self: Reception will be learning even more about how to identify and moderate difficult feelings that they have, both socially and emotionally. Keeping healthy: This half term reception will be learning about healthy foods and the different things we can do to stay healthy. 	<p>Physical Development Games</p> <div data-bbox="1241 1256 1401 1402">  </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Every Tuesday reception will spend an hour with Coach Zahra who works as a MCFC 'City in the Community coach' providing specialist teaching to support rapid early years physical development. Children will explore different ways to move. They will develop their climbing and hopping skills and overall body strength as well as co-ordination and balance.
<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reception will be exploring the unique art by Andy Goldsworthy. We will be exploring the use of natural materials in art. We will be making minibeasts based on the characters from our books. 	<p>Understanding the World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recognising similarities and differences between life in the country we live in and life in other countries.
