# Teaching and Learning at St Philip's C of E Primary School

Class: Miss Donnelly Year 2 Half Term: Autumn 1 2022

Your child will be learning about the following this half term:

#### Literacy

Fiction – pupils will write a story with a focus on characters.

### Pupils will learn to:

- plan what is going to be written about.
- use punctuation correctly full stops, capital letters.
- use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify.
- use subordination (because) and coordination (and).



## **Numeracy**

Place Value – pupils will develop a good understanding of numbers to 100.

### Pupils will learn to:

- Count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward or backward.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones).
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, inc. the number line.
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs.
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words.

#### Science

**Animals Including Humans** 

#### Pupils will learn to:

- observe that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival eg the need for water, food and air.
- describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene. eg for nutritional purposes.
- list/draw the things an animal needs to live/survive and understand that they live in different habitats.



### Geography

Weather & Seasons

## Pupils will learn to:

- develop locational and place knowledge about their locality, and the UK as a whole.
- understand basic subject-specific vocabulary relating to physical geography.
- begin to use geographical skills, including first-hand observation, to enhance their locational awareness.
- identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK.
- use simple fieldwork and observational skills in their school, its grounds and surroundings.
- use and construct basic symbols in a key

 create their own troll Joan Miro style using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.
