Your child will be learning about the following this half term:

Literacy

Pupils will learn to:

- plan what they are going to write about.
- use punctuation correctly – full stops, capital letters.
- use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify.
- use subordination (because) and coordination (and).



Numeracy

Multiplication & Division



Pupils will learn to:



- recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.
- calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the multiplication tables and write them using the multiplication (\times), division (\div) and equals ($=$) signs.
- that multiplication of two numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and division of one number by another cannot.

Science

Animals Including Humans

Pupils will learn to:

- observe that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival eg the need for water, food and air.
- describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene. eg for nutritional purposes.
- list/draw the things an animal needs to live/survive and understand that they live in different habitats.



Geography

The Gunpowder Plot and The Great Fire of London

Pupils will:

- develop an awareness of the past, using common words and phrases relating to the passing of time.
- choose and use parts of stories and other sources that they know and understand key features of events.
- understand some of the ways in which we find out about the past.
- identify different ways in which it is represented.
- use a wide vocabulary of everyday historical terms.
- know where events they study fit within a chronological framework.



Design Technology

A Balanced Diet

Pupils will:

- name the main food groups and identify foods that belong to each group.
- describe the taste, texture and smell of a given food.
- think of four different wrap ideas, considering flavour combinations.
- construct a wrap that meets the design brief and their plan.

Music

Ourselves

Pupils will learn to:

- discover ways to use their voices to describe feelings and moods.
- Create and notate vocal sounds, building to a performance.



ICT/Computing

Photography

- Pupils will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, they will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.
