Your child will be learning about the following this half term:

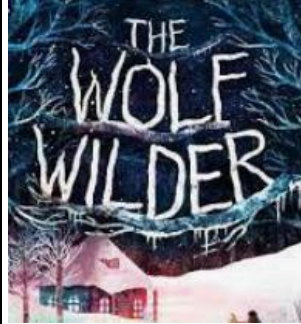
### Writing

- During writing lessons this half term, we will be looking at the book Leaf. A wonderful tale of an out-of-place polar bear.



### Reading

- In guided reading, we will hone our retrieval, clarification and inference skills by reading short extracts from texts like The Wolf Wilder and The Whale Boy.



### Geography

- In our topic of geography this half term, Y5 will be focussing on The Alps in Europe.
- We will use crucially important resources like indexes, atlases, co-ordinates, grid references and ordnance survey maps to learn about the regions physical and human geography

### Numeracy

Fractions, Decimals and Percentages

- Continuing on from our work on fractions last half term, Year 5 will be delving into decimals and percentages.
- The link between fractions, decimals and eventually percentages will be made clear through understanding, practicing and applying all the knowledge we've gathered in numeracy so far.

### Computing

- In computing, we will focus on flat-file databases, how they are used and how they work in sorting through lots of information quickly and efficiently.
